The Sacrament of First Eucharist is a big step in the life of a believer. Also known as "First Holy Communion", it is the moment when a person receives for the first time, the Eucharist, the body of Christ in the form of a host of bread consecrated by the priest. Along with Baptism and Confirmation, First Eucharist is one of the three Sacraments of Initiation into the faith community of the Catholic Church.

Through the Eucharist, God comes to dwell in us. Jesus wants us to receive it as food as it brings us into the fullness of our life in Christ.

The Eucharist is 'the source and summit of the Christian life.' (Lumen Gentium 11)'. The other sacraments, and indeed all ecclesiastical ministries and works of the apostolate, are bound up with the Eucharist and are oriented toward it.

Our Year 4 children are currently preparing to receive the Sacrament for the first time over the coming weeks.

Please pray for them as they continue their faith journey.



The ICT levy will continue in 2024 for our students in Grade 3 and Grade 4, as higher grades will still be part of the previous BYOD Program.

In 2025 the levy will be extended to Grades 3, Grades 4 and Grades 5.

If your family is eligible for the Reduced Fees Policy and you have been approved through the formal approval process, then the ICT levy will be included in the discount fees offered.

<u>CSEF</u>

CAMPS, SPORTS & EXCURSIONS FUND (CSEF) School camps provide children with inspiring experiences in the great outdoors. Excursions encourage a deeper understanding of how the world works while sports teach teamwork, discipline and leadership. All are a part of a healthy curriculum.

CSEF is provided by the Victorian Government to assist eligible families to cover the costs of school trips, camps and sporting activities.

If you hold a valid means-tested concession card or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible for CSEF. A special consideration category also exists for asylum seeker and refugee families. The allowance is paid to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions or sporting activities for the benefit of your child.



Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund APPLICATION Form

The annual CSEF amount per student is:\$150 for primary school students.

HOW TO APPLY:

New applicants should contact the school office to obtain a CSEF application form or download a copy by <u>clicking here.</u>

If you applied for CSEF at your child's school last year, you do not need to complete an application form this year unless there has been a change in your family circumstances.

- ⇒ You only need to complete an application form if any of the following changes have occurred: new student enrolments; your child has started or changed schools this year.
- ⇒ changed family circumstances; such as a change of custody, change of name, concession card number, or new siblings commencing this year.

Check with the school office if you are unsure.
